Prayer Guide:

You are free to pray however the Holy Spirit leads, if you need a few ideas to get started or guide the event, below is a suggested outline for an hour event.

Introduce yourself, explain the point of this time of gathering *(to agree and pray for the students, families and administrators in and through the name of Jesus Christ)*. Ask someone to pray to open group prayer time. Invite others to pray (see suggested themes below). When group prayer is complete invite everyone to pray individually or in small groups. Before dismissing have an official closing prayer of agreement for the school year with all participants at your location.

Campus Safety

Pray for God to protect the Campus. Pray for His angels to dwell in that place. Pray against all evil and tactics of the devil. *“May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble; may the name of the God of Jacob protect you. May He send you help from the sanctuary and grant you support from Zion” (Psalm 20:1-2).*

Spiritual Awakening

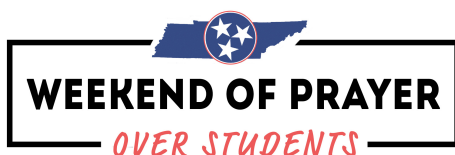
Pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Pray for the lost to be found. Pray for the Gospel of Jesus Christ to be made know and to bear fruit. *“Restore to me the joy of your salvation and uphold me with a willing spirit. Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you” (Psalms 51:12-13).*

Student Missionaries

Pray for students to be salt and light. Pray for them to make disciples. Pray for them to plug back into the local church. *“I am sending you to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, so that they might receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me” (Acts 28:17-18).*

Administration and Faculty

Pray for unity among the school staff. Pray for joy in their calling as educators. Pray that teachers would speak truth. *“First of all, then, I urge that prayers, supplications, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and those in high positions...” (1 Timothy 2:1-2).*
